



Central Data Exchange Modernization

The Central Data Exchange (CDX) is a web-based application designed to provide various stakeholders the ability to submit data to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and participating program offices. For the first time since its inception, the application will receive a modernization to the EPA's current look and feel. This modernization only affects the visual layout and appearance of the application and keeps core system functionalities unchanged.

Examples of pages with the new look and feel:

CDX Home Page

The updated CDX home page improves the user productivity by moving the log in and registration capabilities into the header section of the page. The page also provides important alerts and notices for users to view upon navigating to the home page. The user has the ability to navigate to other CDX pages by using the hyperlinks within the CDX Navigation section.
